Rio Frio Slate Rio Frio slate belongs geologically to the "San Pedro de las Herrerías" formation (Middle-upper Ordovician). Its main minerals are sericite, chlorite and quartz, and it also contains other opaque minerals and tourmaline. It has a great schistosity, the grain is fine and smooth. It is very solid and also very suitable as roofing material. Its use is recommended for covers in all climates and weather conditions.

Waterproof: it fulfils this property perfectly well because it is compact and pore-exempt, thus avoiding cracking caused by frost.

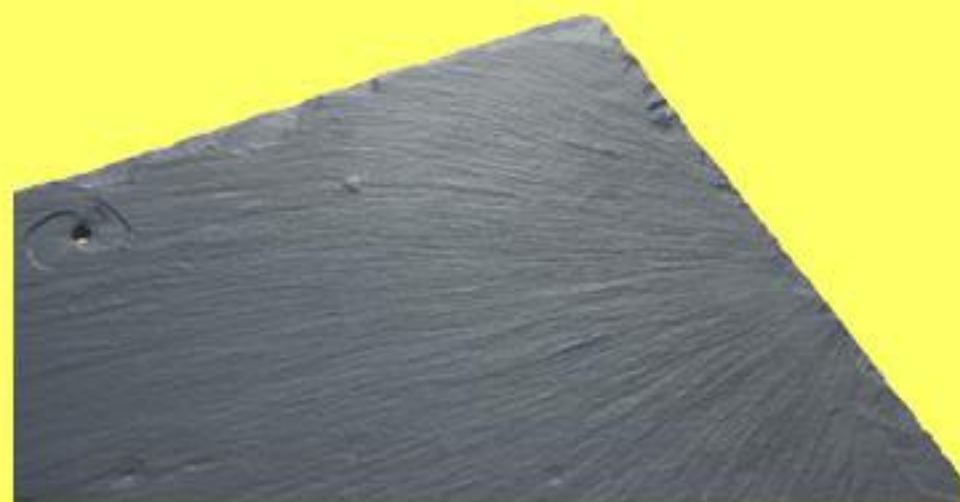
Inalterable: it remains unchanged under wind, dust, salt residue, cold, heat, snow and humidity.
